Food for Thought

Snickers or Milky Way Bar Cookies – beat together 1 Cup Sugar 1 Cup firmly packed brown sugar 1 Cup soft butter 1 Cup peanut butter 1 ½ Teaspoon vanilla

2 Eggs

Slowly blend in: 3 Cups of Flour

1 Teaspoon of baking powder

1 Teaspoon of baking soda

¹⁄₄ Teaspoon of salt





40 Snickers Mini's or 40 Milky Way Mini's or mix them up 20 & 20.

Shape the dough around each candy bar, covering it completely. Set approx 2 inches apart on ungreased cookie sheet. Bake at 375 degrees for 13 to 16 minutes.
