Ecolab and the American Hotel & Lodging Educational Institute Launch Online Toolkit to Help Hotels Address Growing Problem of Bed Bugs

November 15, 2010 – Ecolab Inc. and the American Hotel & Lodging Educational Institute (AHLEI) today announced the launch of www.bedbugtoolkit.com, a free online resource to help hotel owners and operators stop bed bugs before they spread. The toolkit features downloadable information and materials on how to train staff to detect bed bugs early, as well as actions to take when they suspect a guest room is infested. The toolkit debuted at the International Hotel/Motel & Restaurant Show in New York City.

"In the last decade, bed bugs have rebounded because of increased international travel, pesticide resistance and a lack of awareness – but hoteliers can rest assured they are treatable, especially if caught early," said Dr. John Barcay, urban entomologist and senior scientist with Ecolab Pest Elimination.
